## Venous Examination

Lower extremity continuous wave doppler examination reveals spontaneous phasic distal augmentable flow in the common femoral, superficial femoral, popliteal and posterior tibial veins bilaterally.

High resolution duplex ultrasonographic imaging of the lower extremity veins demonstrates easily compressible veins without evidence of intraluminal echogenic material.

## Venous Reflux Examination

Venous refill times in the common femoral, superficial femoral, popliteal and posterior tibial veins bilaterally are not prolonged.

## Impression:

**No evidence of deep venous thrombosis of the lower extremities bilaterally**

**No evidence of venous valvular incompetence bilaterally**
